The initiation of the Partnership to Strengthen Transparency for co-Innovation (PaSTI)-Japan ASEAN Integration Fund (JAIF) project on the development of guidelines and information platform on facility level GHG Measurement and Reporting in ASEAN countries was endorsed by the ASEAN Working Group on Climate Change (AWGCC) in December 2021. Since then, ASEAN member states (AMS) have made a significant joint effort in contributing to the deliverables of the project which will reflect the needs and circumstances of the ASEAN region, while ensuring universality and robustness in alignment with relevant international standards and practices. The event at the Singapore Pavilion will introduce the results of deliberation by the AMS, with insights from key international experts, towards the finalization of the guidelines. The event will also provide an opportunity to engage in discussion on the potential next steps of AMS.
