How PaSTI Started



PaSTI was established...

- In 2017 at the UNFCCC COP23
- By the Ministry of the Environment, Japan (MOEJ)
- As a main cooperation programme for the area of transparency in the "ASEAN-Japan Climate Change Action Agenda", aiming to strengthen the regional cooperation on climate change with ASEAN countries through the three pillars:

Adaptation


Mitigation

- = PaSTI project supported by the Japan-ASEAN Integration Fund (JAIF)
- Official project title:

 Development and implementation of facility level

 Measurement and Reporting (M&R) framework for

 greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions with engagement of state

 and non-state actors in ASEAN member states (AMS)
- Proponent:
 National Environment Agency, Singapore (NEA)
- Implementing Agency:
 Overseas Environmental Cooperation Center, Japan (OECC)



Activity 1: Support to the Government (Policy/Institutional support)


To strengthen understanding of the next steps toward developing facility level GHG emission M&R framework based on gap and needs analysis

Activity 2: Support to target facility

To build capacity for the private sector in GHG emission M&R



Phase 3: Pilot project example for country A





Identify the needs of each participating country

The government of country A decides to develop the GHG emissions
Measurement and Reporting framework.

The company of country A decides to calculate its GHG emissions.

Conduct pilot project customized for each participating country

Example of Activity 1: Support to the Government


Hold seminars for relevant ministries and agencies for a better understanding of the subject.

Example of Activity 2: Support to target facility

Hold seminars for relevant stakeholder to strengthen understanding of the needs of calculation of GHG emission.

Phase 3: Pilot project example for country B





Identify the needs of each participating country

The government of country B is considering the details of the framework but has no reporting template.

Conduct pilot project customized for each participating country

Example of Activity 1:
Support to the
Government

Develop reporting template.

The company of country B understands the technical aspects required to calculate GHG emissions and needs to decide the methodology.

Example of Activity 2: Support to target facility

Hold seminars on the methodology for GHG emissions, develop automatic calculation tool.



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Phase 3: What has been done so far



Objective I: Facilitating smooth introduction and operationalization of M&R framework in the AMS

Output: Implementation of pilot projects in AMS with the usage of the ASEAN guidelines

Planned activities:

- Advisory and consultation support to the AMS in developing and implementing respective GHG M&R Systems
 - → Bilateral consultation with each AMS is in progress
 - → Target sector has been identified for some AMS
- Piloting M&R of GHG at up to 10 facilities in AMS
 - → Facilities will be determined according to the bilateral consultation
- Updating & improving the ASEAN Guidelines
 - → Will be updated according to the result of the pilot project
- Updating & improving the MRV Information Platform
 - → Updated on Aug 2023 *To be updated as needed

Phase 3: What has been done so far



Objective II: Promoting and supporting the AMS government's efforts to incentivize the private sector in GHG M&R and emissions reduction

Output: Identifying and sharing good practices/case studies of ESG finance and transparency for wide replication in AMS

Output: Developing a Policy Brief regarding application of ESG finance linked with transparency in ASEAN region

→ Information collection & desk study in progress

Phase 3: What has been done so far



Objective III: Conducting capacity building technical seminars for AWGCC National Focal Points (NFPs)

Output: PaSTI Technical Seminars on

> GHG Measurement & Reporting System

Development of Incentives the private sector, linking ESG Finance and Transparency

Planned activities:

- Holding technical seminars in order to strengthen institutional and human capacity building in the context of their own national circumstances
 - → Seminar & Workshop held in Aug 2023 (During ASEAN-Japan Environment Week to Commemorate 50th Anniversary)
 - → More seminars coming up
